Bill 21 (The Retirement Homes Act) has been passed, but as long term members of ORCA (The Ontario Retirement Communities Association) we have been adhering to superior industry standards for decades. ORCA is a voluntary, non-profit association established in 1977 that sets professional operating standards, inspects, and accredits retirement residences in Ontario.

Not all retirement residences are approved members of ORCA. Members of ORCA must meet and maintain standards for accreditation which pertain to the operational policies, procedures, and staff education essential to fulfilling legislated obligations and the maintenance of a safe, comfortable living environment for residents. 


